The *WEST*local X91, known locally as the “Chew Valley Sprint” successfully launched in April 2024. This *WEST*local service is managed by the Chew Valley CIC Sustainable Transport Partnership who are passionate about the benefits of travelling by bus: for individual convenience, community connection, personal health and wellbeing and as a simple pragmatic way to address the climate and nature emergency; decreasing local congestion and pollution and lowering the carbon footprint of transport in the area.

Initially a once-a-day commuter route, the *WEST*local X91 Chew Valley Sprint will now offer three return journeys to Bristol from seven villages. By having limited stops only and using bus lanes, the *WEST*local provides a fast service and will operate Monday to Friday (except bank holidays).
