BROMLEY ROAD, STANTON DREW – TTRN1585
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY VEHICLES

In pursuance of Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that on Thursday 15th May 2025, Bromley Road, Stanton Drew shall be closed to all traffic, in the interests of public safety, to enable Bristol Water to repair a leaking outlet.

The road will be closed at Bromley Road, Stanton Drew from a point outside the property known as Long Roof, but the closure shall not apply to any vehicle associated with the works.

Alternative Route: Bromley Road (remainder) – A368 – Moorledge Road – Tunbridge Road – B3130 – Bromley Road – Vice versa.

The closure and diversion will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works.

These works will commence on **Thursday 15th May 2025** and the road closure is anticipated to be required for **2 days**. This Notice will have a maximum duration of **5 days**.
